The Team Experience

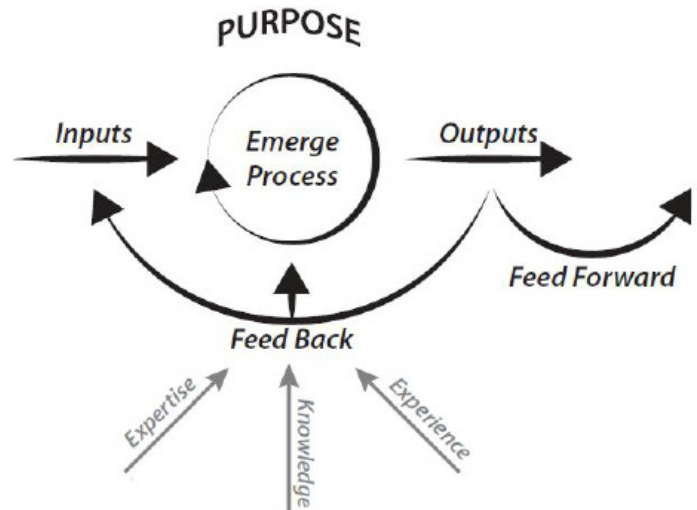
The EMERGE session design is based on systems models. Working with your leader, the Team Consultant will help construct or collect:

- The Purpose for the Meeting – all activity in the meeting will be aligned to the Purpose Statement.
- All relevant inputs – whitepapers, PowerPoint presentations, documents, emails, etc. There is no limit to inputs as long as they exist in a printable or drawable form.
- A list of outputs that the Leader desires. Outputs will be stated in concrete deliverable terms.

The Team Consultant will “animate” the Emerge process instead of “facilitate” because the role is very different from a traditional meeting facilitator. The EMERGE session outputs will be visible, concrete, consensus-based and actionable. Feedback and Feedforward are process designs unique to each session and based on the original Purpose.
